NewPipe is a safe alternative to the YouTube app that lets you access YouTube without Google.

It has absolutely no ads, no For You page, and no Shorts feed.

You can search the YouTube library without an algorithm pushing irrelevant videos in the results.

You can subscribe to channels, create playlists, and browse comments.

This app also lets you play videos in the background, download them in high quality, add videos to queues, and make playlists.

What you can't do is leave comments because it doesn't connect to a Google account.

If you want to build a fresh YouTube feed from scratch

or if you waste too much time on YouTube,

I cannot recommend this app enough.

The System Restore tool in Windows is one of the more helpful utilities

available to you and is

usually a great first step when you're trying to fix a major problem in Windows.

In a nutshell, what the Windows System Restore tool lets you do is revert to a previous software, registry, and driver configuration called a restore point.

It's like "undoing" the last major change to Windows, taking your computer back to the way it was when the restore point was created.

Since a majority of Windows problems involve issues with at least one of

those aspects of your operating system,

System Restore is a great tool to use early in the troubleshooting process. It also helps that it's really simple to do.

Using the System Restore tool to undo/reverse changes in Windows usually takes anywhere from 10 to 30 minutes, at least in most cases.

Follow these easy steps to return Windows to a previous, hopefully working, state using System Restore.

Clear Browsing History and Cache

As you browse the web, your browser stores data like cached images, cookies, and site data.

While this data helps speed up your browsing and loading times on

subsequent visits, it can consume a significant portion of your storage if it's not cleared periodically.

To free up space, you have to clear this data out.

To clear your browsing data, click the three vertical dots in the top-right corner

and select "Settings." Next, go to Privacy and Security > Delete Browsing Data, choose your desired time range, check the boxes for the data you're comfortable deleting, and click "Delete Data."

If browsing data has been taking up a lot of storage, you must make a habit of clearing it regularly to prevent your storage from filling up.

Look at the data types mentioned above to see what's taking up space on your device, then remove any unnecessary apps, downloaded files, offline cloud data, and browsing data.

Additionally, consider moving files to the cloud or external drives to clear up more space.

If it's unexpected or urgent, slow down... no quick-pay links, open your bank or service app directly instead.

2. Ring a caller back on a verified number

If money or data is involved, do not provide this on an incoming call.

Ring the company on the number on their website or your card, not the one in the message.

3. Assume anyone can be fooled

Treat every email as suspicious.

Use strong logins like passkeys, and keep less personal info public (private Facebook profiles) so scammers have less to mimic.
